Blue Growth is the focus of the third annual conference of the Irish Sea Maritime Forum and we are very pleased to link the event to the International Festival of Business that is being held in Liverpool in the summer of 2014.

The conference aims to showcase the Blue Growth potential in the Irish Sea region and to feed into an ISMF report on this subject – the key Forum output for 2014.

The first session will set the scene by introducing the EU's ambitions for Blue Growth and how different parts of the Irish Sea region are taking this agenda forward, including the host city Liverpool.

In the second session ideas to create a vibrant Irish Sea Rim economic, research and innovation zone will be introduced.
